From the South:

Take 465 North to 38th St. (Exit 17). At the top of the ramp, turn right. Turn left at the light onto Moller Road. Follow this road and veer slightly to the right onto West Pike Plaza Road. This road turns into Georgetown Road. Turn right at the light at West Century Plaza Road. Turn left into the Georgetown Medical Plaza and take immediate right into parking lot.

From the North:

Take 465 West to 65 South (Exit 20). Take the Lafayette Road exit (Exit 121). At the bottom of the ramp turn right. Go one mile to Georgetown Rd. / Pike Plaza Rd. Turn left at the light. Turn right at the next light, West Century Plaza Road. Turn left into the Georgetown Medical Plaza and take immediate right into parking lot.
